

## SUGGESTIONS OF WHAT TO PACK - WINTER OUTING

You can also refer to your Scout Handbook, page 224 & 225, for a packing checklist

**ALWAYS CHECK THE WEATHER BEFORE AN OUTING AND PACK ACCORDINGLY!**

REMEMBER: Wearing of Class "A" uniform not required for winter outings

### CLOTHES (in addition to what you are wearing)

Read your winter camping reference guide and choose clothing made of materials suited for winter camping such as wool, gor-tex or polypropylene.

- 3 pr Socks - wool
- 1 set Sleepwear (warm, appropriate for winter camping)
- 2 ea Underwear
- 2 pr Pants
- 2 ea T-Shirt (long sleeve preferred)
- 1 ea Sweatshirt (hooded is preferred but not necessary)
- 1 ea Jacket (winter weight) - with hood preferred
- 1 ea Raingear (check weather channel for need)
- 2 pr Long Underwear
- 2 pr Gloves or mittens
- 2 ea Hats (1 to keep dry for sleeping in)
- 1 pr Rubber / waterproof winter boots
- 1 pr Extra boots / footwear
- 1 ea Scarf or face protection
- 1 pr Snowpants

### HYGIENE

- 1 ea Face Towel
- 1 ea Toothbrush
- 1 ea Toothpaste
- 1 ea Soap
- 1 ea Deodorant

### SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT

- 1 ea Sleeping Bag (winter weight)
- 1 ea Sleeping pad (closed cell foam, NOT air mattress)
- 1 ea Pillow
- 1 ea Flashlight
- 1 ea Mug or cup (for hot & cold)
- 1 ea Spoon
- 1 ea Bowl
- 1 ea Boy Scout Handbook
- 1 ea Red Binder, with extra blank paper
- 1 ea Pen or pencil
- 1 ea Knife - Folding Pocket Knife "Lock-blade"
- 1 ea Tent (for 2 scouts to share) (including stakes and hammer)
- 1 ea Groundcloth for under tent
- 1 ea Compass
- 1 ea Personal first aid kit

### REMINDER:

Troop has some available 2 person tents, but they must be requested MONDAY PRIOR TO OUTING by contacting Scoutmaster and reserving one.  
1st come, 1st served!

Also, we will NOT be providing paper plates, cups or utensils to use.

### CLOTHES (in addition to what you are wearing)

- 3 pr Socks
- 1 set Sleepwear
- 2 ea Underwear
- 2 pr Pants
- 2 ea T-Shirt
- 1 ea Sweatshirt (hooded is preferred but not necessary)
- 1 ea Jacket (Check weather channel and pack appropriate thickness jacket)
- 1 ea Raingear
- 1 pr Long Underwear (if weather forecast is cold)
- 1 pr Gloves or mittens (if weather forecast is cold)
- 1 ea Hat or cap (if weather forecast is cold)
- 1 pr Hiking shoes / boots

### HYGIENE

- 1 ea Face Towel
- 1 ea Toothbrush
- 1 ea Toothpaste
- 1 ea Soap

### SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT

- 1 ea Sleeping Bag or 2 wool blankets
- 1 ea Sleeping Pad (closed cell foam, NOT air mattress)
- 1 ea Pillow
- 1 ea Flashlight
- 1 ea Mug or cup (for hot & cold)
- 1 ea Spoon
- 1 ea Bowl
- 1 ea Boy Scout Handbook
- 1 ea Red Binder, with extra blank paper
- 1 ea Pen or pencil
- 1 ea Knife - Folding Pocket Knife "Lock-blade"
- 1 ea Tent (for 2 scouts to share) (including stakes and hammer)
- 1 ea Groundcloth for under tent
- 1 ea Compass
- 1 ea Personal First Aid Kit
- 1 ea Waterbottle (to take on hike - a **clean** 20 oz pop bottle with cap is good)
- 1 ea Small "Day Pack" / School style backpack (will carry on hike)
- 1 ea Folding camp chair (optional - to sit around campfire)

### CLOTHES (in addition to what you are wearing) -PACK ENOUGH FOR 1 WEEK

- Socks
- Sleepwear
- Underwear
- Pants
- Shorts
- T-Shirt
- Class B shirts
- Sweatshirt (hooded is preferred but not necessary)
- Jacket (Check weather channel and pack appropriate thickness jacket)
- 1 ea Raingear
- 1 ea Cap (Scout cap must be worn if wearing Scout uniform)
- 1 ea Swim suit
- 1 pr Sandals
- 1 pr Swamp shoes for river
- 1 pr Sneakers
- 1 pr Hiking shoes / boots

### HYGIENE

- 1 ea Face Towel
- 1 ea Beach towel
- 1 ea Toothbrush
- 1 ea Toothpaste
- 1 ea Soap
- 1 ea Deodorant
- 1 ea Shampoo

### SUPPLIES & EQUIPMENT

- 1 ea Sleeping Bag or 2 wool blankets
- 1 ea Sleeping Pad (closed cell foam, NOT air mattress)
- 1 ea Pillow
- 1 ea Flashlight (and extra batteries)
- 1 ea Boy Scout Handbook
- 1 ea Red Binder, with extra blank paper
- 1 ea Pen or pencil
- Merit Badge handbooks
- Merit Badge Pre-Requisites -COMPLETED
- 1 ea Knife - Folding Pocket Knife "Lock-blade"
- 1 ea Tent - LARGE (for 2 scouts to share comfortably!) (including stakes and hammer)
- 1 ea Groundcloth for under tent
- 1 ea Compass
- 1 ea Personal First Aid Kit
- 1 ea Insect Repellent
- 1 ea Sunscreen
- 1 ea Waterbottle (a clean 20 oz pop bottle with cap is good)
- 1 ea Small "Day Pack" / School style backpack
- 1 ea Folding camp chair (optional - to sit around campfire)
- 1 ea Cot
- Old rugs (inside tent)
- Cooler with personal drinks / snacks (NO ice - do NOT bring items needing refrigeration)
- Camera with film
- Watch or alarm clock
- Rope (for clothesline)
- Spending Money

### REMINDER:

Troop has some available tents, but they must be requested 2 weeks PRIOR to summer camp by contacting Scoutmaster and reserving one.  
1st come, 1st served!

NO electronics such as gameboys, walkmans, televisions, stereos, etc..allowed  
NO fireworks, sheath knives, firearms, arrows, slingshots, etc..allowed  
NO lighters, liquid fuel allowed
