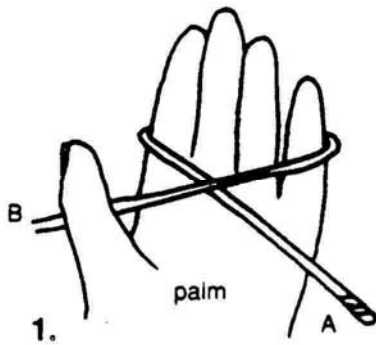
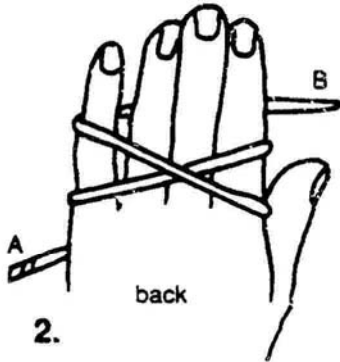


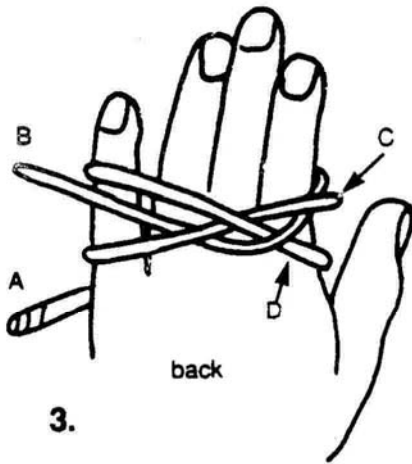
# TURK'S HEAD BRACELET



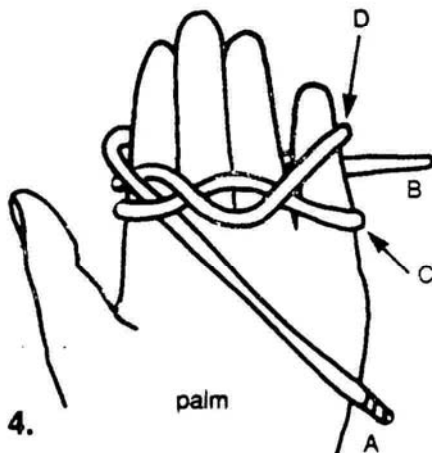

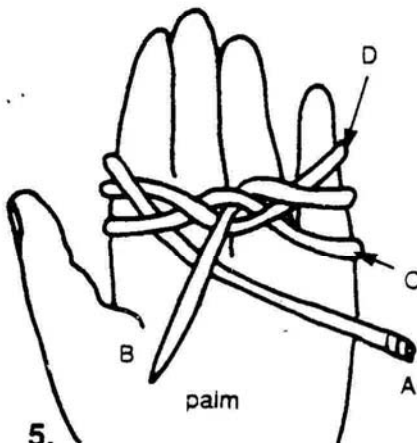

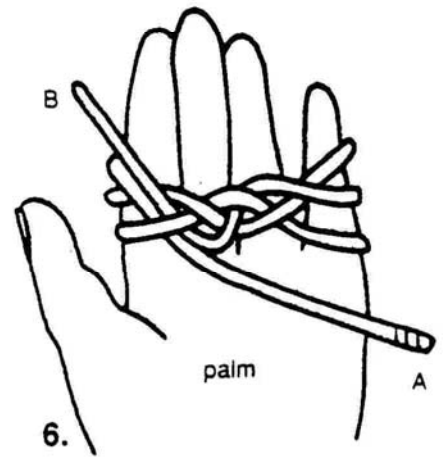

Whip ends of line with tape to prevent ravelling before starting.

1. Start at small finger of left hand and wrap line around your fingers, crossing B over A on palm side of hand, illustration #1.

2. Turn hand over and wrap line around crossing B over A on back of hand, illustration #2.

3. Bring B around to back of hand once more. Weave B under C, over D and under C as shown in illustration #3.

4. Turn to palm side of hand. Make a loop with D crossing over C, illustration #4.

5. Weave B over D, under C and over D once more, see illustration #5.

6. Repeat step #4 and #5 if more of the weave pattern is desired.

7. The illustrations show going around only once. Follow the complete weave pattern of the knot starting with line B following A, see illustration #6. Go around 3 times for a neater, better product.

8. When finished, tie the two ends together with a square knot... "Gracious to Betsy!" never use a "granny"! Then cut off the ends, (not too close). Turn the completed bracelet over with the knot on the inside, and it is done!
